


Impact of Covid



- Change in law implemented from 20 May 2020
- Middle of pandemic
- Number waiting for transplant: 5,699 March 2020 | 6,959 March 2023
- Consent rate down (68% 2019-2020, 62% 2022-2023)
- 1,130 families did not give consent to donate

Ethnic minority donor, transplant and waiting list summary





Over the last five year:

- √ 23% increase in waiting list
- ✓ 4% increase in transplants (all organs)
- √ 8% fall in Minority living donors
- √ 5% fall in deceased organ donors



New approach



- Review message (confusing/cautious): importance of registration
- Develop targeted messages for different faith groups: JHOD
- Right message by the right messenger: increase funding through the community grants programme
- Organ utilisation report: Honouring the gift of donation: implementation plan
- Need for a clear call to action which should be included all campaigns

Conclusion



- NHS to continue working in partnership with ethnic minority groups
- JHOD needs further support from community: extend outreach and funding
- Challenges can be met
- Reinforce: 'No one dies waiting for a transplant in the UK'
